MINUTES OF A SPECIAL CALLED  
CITY COUNCIL MEETING  
SEPTEMBER 11, 2007

The City Council of the City of Hunters Creek Village, Texas held a special called meeting at 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday, September 11, 2007, at City Hall, #1 Hunters Creek Place, Hunters Creek Village, Texas.

With a quorum of the Council Members present, Mayor Dodson called the session to order at 7:20 p.m. It was noted that Councilmember Roger Stark was not in attendance.

1. Receive presentations for proposals for residential solid waste and recycling collection and disposal services contract from Century Disposal Inc., BNC Services Company, and Republic Waste Services.

Presentations from representatives from Century Disposal (Glen White and Chris Schulz) and from Republic Waste Services (Curtis Lacy and Johnnie Smith) were received by council. During the presentations, each company explained their methods for the collection of garbage and recycling, disposal of same, customer service, type of equipment used, and experience. During the course of the presentation by Republic Waste it was ascertained that their proposal provided for a limited number of bags for pick up for yard waste instead of the unlimited number specified in the bid specifications. It was noted that BNC Services Company, apparent lower bidder, was not in attendance for the presentations.

2. Discussion and possible action to consider the award of the bid for a residential solid waste and recycling collection and disposal services contract.

Following the presentations, it was the consensus of the council that the item be moved to the regular meeting on September 18 to allow the mayor to investigate the equipment used by Century Disposal and allow for staff to check references.

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With no further comments forthcoming, a motion was made by Councilmember Wegner with a second by Councilmember Burck to adjourn the meeting. The motion carried unanimously. The meeting adjourned at 9:15 p.m.
